

TIMBER GRAIN

Timber knobs are available in two versions, routed cross grain and turned end grain. Routed knobs have the cross grain on top, like you have on a wooden front. Turned knobs have the end grain on top of the knob.



Cross grain knobs -

Individually routed from a fixed wooden block with a full shaped tool. Each knob is then sanded to the final shape. This method of manufacture makes for a higher quality knob that shows the natural wood grain to it's best

End grain knobs -

Traditional turned knobs are turned on a copy lathe from a long turning wood dowel and cut off automatically. This method of manufacture is faster and produces a more economical and cost effective product

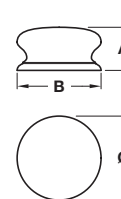

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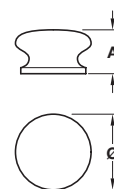
