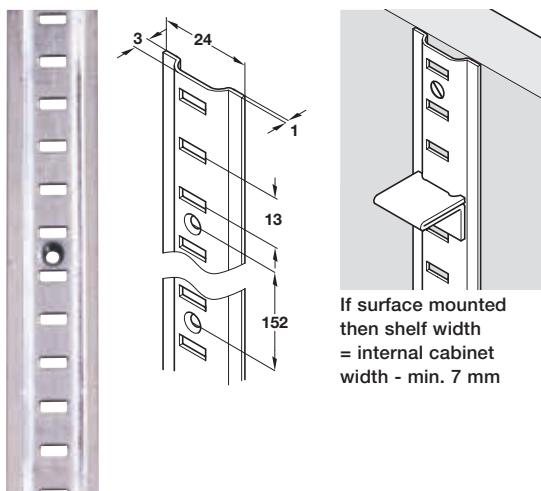


Raised bookcase strip



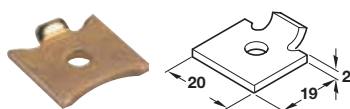
- > Designed for surface fixing
- > Low profile and fewer fixing holes-cost effective
- > Wide flanges for possible surface spot welding
- > Ideal for installation within sheet metal cabinets
- > Top hat section for greater strength
- > Steel
- > Order qty: 1 pc (1 pc = 1829 mm)

Shelf support stud, single

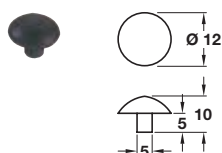

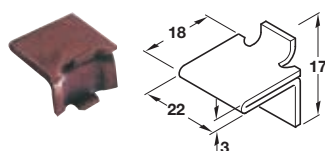
Shelf support buffer
