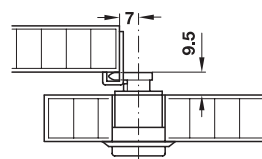

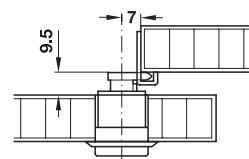

Cabinet Locks, Catches and Bolts: Locks

- > 180° Closure direction:
- > The rotary bolt further protects high sliding doors against being pushed in
- > Can only be locked and unlocked by the key
- > Closure direction A or B

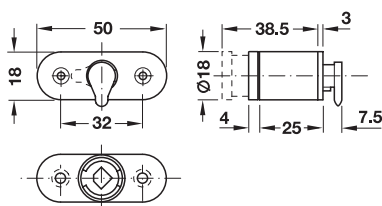


Closure direction A

Symo 3000 push and turn lock



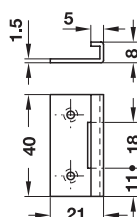
- > For on-site installation of cylinder cores

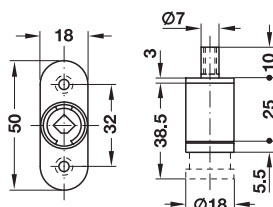
